Bridgewater State is the eighth largest higher education institution in Massachusetts and predominantly enrolls first-generation students. Dr. Pina provides leadership for over 375 employees that serve 11,500 students. The Division of Student Affairs comprises traditional student engagement departments (Athletics & Recreation, Career Services, Children's Center, Community Standards, Counseling Center, Health Services, Multicultural Affairs, Pride Center, Residence Life and Housing and Student Involvement & Leadership) as well as the undergraduate enrollment management functions (Admission, Financial Aid and Transfer Central).

Dr. Pina has an intense drive to serve and develop students while increasing the worth of their degrees. For over 20 years, Dr. Pina has collaborated with professional and student colleagues to improve campus environments, student achievement and student affairs programs. His research interests center on the impact of presidential leadership on issues of diversity on campuses.

Dr. Pina's current NASPA involvement includes serving on the James Scott Academy Board, AVP Steering Committee, 2014-2016 AVP Institute faculty, ACPA/NASPA Professional Competencies Taskforce and co-editing a leadership related book available in December 2015.
